

Ordinance No. 285-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1109-2021, passed November 29, 2021, authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into an agreement with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc. for the Food Distribution Program through the use of Casino Revenue Funds, and repealing Ordinance No. 42-2023, passed January 9, 2023.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1109-2021, passed November 29, 2021, are hereby amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into an agreement Burton, Bell, Carr Development Inc., for the Food Distribution Program through the use of ~~Ward~~ Wards 4 and 5 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement effective November 5, 2021, with Burten, Bell, Carr Development Inc., for the Food Distribution Program for the public purpose of providing food cards to low/moderate income residents residing in the city of Cleveland through the use of ~~Ward 5 4~~ Ward 5 4 (\$15,000 - G22548) and ~~Ward 5~~ Ward 5 (\$15,000 - G21512) Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed ~~\$15,000~~ \$30,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That the Title and Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 1109-2021, passed November 29, 2021, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 42-2023, passed January 3, 2023, is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
