Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control ("Department") is requesting to amend Contract No.PS2019-51, with EnviroScience Inc. to extend the term of the contract an additional twelve (12) months for professional services necessary to provide professional environmental Analytical Services; and add an additional \$350,000 for the remainder of the contract, for the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

This request will provide the Department of Port Control with the needed support to provide professional environmental analytical services, without a lapse in services, until a new contract can be executed.

Scope:

This legislation will allow the Department of Port Control to continue the current contract with EnviroScience Inc. for environmental analytical services for an additional twelve (12) months. The Department has posted an RFQ for a new environmental services contract, to umbrella the Department's environmental services under a single contract, with the intention of creating a more cohesive structure and a reduction in cost. The contract extension will include the following tasks in order to maintain compliance with the Ohio EPA, renew the NPDES permit, and make progress on treatment design:

- Task 1-Program management and coordination
- Task 2-NPDES permit renewal & analytical
- Task 3- Biofilm sampling and reporting
- Task 4- Survey, treatment design, and SPCC Plan
- Task 5- On call services
- Task 6- Basin improvements

Justification/Urgency:

To maintain uninterrupted environmental analytical services for Cleveland Airport System. Activities required are to meet compliance with local, state, and federal permits, orders, regulations (Ohio EPA National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit), and guidance.

Anticipated Cost:

\$350,000

Schedule or Term of Contract:

Twelve (12) months
