AMEND Ord. 761-2022 (GF Public Works & Public Safety)
Various On-Road and Off-Road Equipment

Ordinance: 373-2023

Purpose: An emergency ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 761-2022, passed September 19, 2022, for a direct award to McLean Company and Columbus Equipment, authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into contract for the purchase, lease, or lease with option to purchase by one or more standard contracts, of three (3) rollers, two (2) pavers and tar distributor needed for the 2023 residential resurfacing project.

The reason we are asking for Passage under Suspension of the Rules is due to the high demand for this equipment and the limited quantity with other vendors. Obtaining the equipment now will ensure that we are getting the equipment needed for the residential resurfacing project. If we do not act now, we will be delayed by one-year and will not have access to the vehicles needed for this project.
