The Department of Public Works, Division of Waste Collection & Disposal has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$6,000.00 from the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District, for the purpose of funding one year of an electronic newsletter to all residents enrolled in the recycling program, via Mailchimp, or a similar application, using contact information residents provided at signup.

Per attached copy of the Administrative Code, Chapter 121, section 121.06 "The Director of any department is hereby authorized to accept grants and donations from various entities, both public and private to conduct the operation of the director's department, provided that the proceeds of such grant shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00)".

The grant will be used by the Division of Waste Collection to provide residents with correspondence meant to give them confidence that the recycling program is working, to motivate them to participate, to inform them how to recycle seasonal items, and to help identify and correct contamination issues we see at the transfer station or at the vendor's facility.

Therefore, the Director of Public Works accepts the grant in the amount of \$6,000.00, from the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District.

§ 121.06 Application and Acceptance of Grants

The director of any department is hereby authorized to apply for and accept grants from various entities, both public and private, to conduct the operation of the director's department, provided that the proceeds of each grant shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) and provided further that the City is not obligated to provide in cash matching funds as a condition of receiving the grant. The director of any department is further authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under said grants and, upon acceptance of said grants by a director pursuant to this section, the grant funds shall be appropriated for the purposes set forth in the grant agreement. The director shall notify the Clerk of Council of the making of any grant application or the acceptance of any grant pursuant to this section.

The login instructions for the toolkit are available in the grant application packet, on page 1 of this agreement, or from the District Contact.
