# Ordinance No. 397-2023

#### By Council Members Hairston and Griffin (by departmental request)

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE Notifying Council of the final budget allocations received from HUD for the 2023 Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnerships Act Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS Grant; and to amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 135-2023, passed March 20, 2023, relating to the grants.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 135-2023, passed March 20, 2023, this Council authorized the Director of Community Development to apply for and accept the 2023 Community Development Block Grant, Home Investment Partnerships Act Grant, Emergency Solutions Grant, and the Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS

### Grant; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 135-2023 contained estimated amounts of the grant

funds to be received and estimated amounts allocated to recipient programs; and

WHEREAS, the City has received the final budget allocations; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 3. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 135-2023, passed March 20, 2023,

is repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
