AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts with BancTec, Inc. for system upgrades and hardware and software support and maintenance services for its payment scanner and payment processing system, for the Division of Utilities Fiscal Control, Department of Public Utilities, for a period of two years.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with BancTec, Inc. for system upgrades and hardware and software support and maintenance services for its payment scanner and payment processing system, on the basis of its proposal dated January 24, 2023, for the Division of Utilities Fiscal Control, Department of Public Utilities, for a period of two years.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Public Utilities may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 50 SF 003. (RQS 2005, RLA 2023-27)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
