## Ordinance No. 250-2023 AS AMENDED

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Soccer Foundation to accept a donation at Lonnie Burten and Halloran Park of two mini-pitch soccer fields with sponsor logos and hashtags, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Soccer Foundation has indicated a desire to make a donation of two mini-pitch soccer fields with sponsor logos, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location; and

WHEREAS, sponsors for the soccer fields include the U.S. Soccer Foundation, Black Players for Change, the Black Women's Player Collective, Mosco Lighting, and Adidas; and

WHEREAS, the two locations where the mini-pitch soccer fields will be installed are Lonnie Burten Park and Halloran Park; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Soccer Foundation to accept a donation at Lonnie Burten and Halloran Park of two mini-pitch soccer fields with sponsor logos and hashtags, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location. The agreement shall include a provision that the City is required to lay asphalt at both sites prior to installation of the mini-pitch soccer fields. The value of the mini-pitch fields and components are approximately \$100,000 each, for an approximate total of \$200,000.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
