

## Department of Port Control

### Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into a professional service contract with Fire Force, Inc., to provide Airport Rescue and Firefighting personnel with annual FAA Part 139 certification training, for the Department of Port Control for a period of one year, with three (3) one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

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#### **Background/Purpose:**

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into a professional service contract with Fire Force, Inc., to provide Airport Rescue and Firefighting personnel with annual FAA Part 139 certification training.

Fire Force, Inc., is the uniquely instate partner that has been certified by the FAA ARFF Training Facilities, for simulated spill fire area requirements, as well as their patented Simulator Aircraft Fire Training Prop. The instructors at Fire Force, Inc. are also certified by the State to provide the EMS, and Rescue and Structural Fire training. Fire Force, Inc. provides mobile on-site training, which enables the Department to conduct the live burn training at the Airport, using DPC equipment and vehicles.

#### **Anticipated Cost:**

\$ 27,500 annually

#### **Schedule or Term of Contract:**

One year, with three (3) one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.
