Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control (“Department”) is requesting authority to exercise the option to renew Contract No. PS2021-214 with CDW Government LLC to provide technical support and maintenance of core information technology activities and other related services to acquire software.

Background/Purpose:

The Department is requesting approval to exercise the options to renew Contract No. PS2021-214 with CDW Government LLC to provide information technology support and maintenance, of core information technology activities, and other related services, through staff augmentation, and to acquire software, for the Department. The Department’s ITS Division requires staff augmentation and managed services contract(s) to complement its ability to provide critical services and technical expertise to the Department’s ITS systems’ stakeholders; including traveling public, airlines staff, airport tenants and Department employees.

Ordinance 557-2019 provides that the second of the three one-year options to renew shall not be exercised without additional legislative authority. The Department is desirous of exercising the second of the one-year options for Contract No. PS2021-214.

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department is requesting to exercise the second of the three one-year options to renew.

\$200,000 annually
