Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to enter into one or more standard and requirement contracts for deicing chemicals for the Department of Port Control, for a period of two years with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control is requesting legislation to authorize the purchase of deicing chemicals necessary to maintain all taxiways and runways, free and clear of accumulations of snow and ice, to ensure the safe operations of aircrafts during the winter season.

Scope of Work:

This contract will provide deicing agents for the Division of Airports in the Department of Port Control.

Justification/Urgency:

The Department of Port Control must ensure the safe operation of aircrafts on the runways and taxiways during the winter season. In order to maintain safe operating conditions, the Department must periodically spread deicing chemicals on the runways and taxiways in order to prevent accumulations of ice and snow.

Anticipated Cost:

\$2,000,000

Schedule or Term of Contract:

The Department is requesting two years with two one-year options for renewal, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.
