ORDINANCE NO: 394-2023

DESCRIPTION:

Authoring the Director of Finance to enter into second amendments to Contract No. PS2019-134 with Cuyahoga County Community and Contract No. PS2019-150 with College Now Greater Cleveland to continue to provide evidence or research-based programs and activities in City Recreation Centers, for up to eighteen additional months.

Contract No. PS 2019-134 with **Cuyahoga Community College District,** extended for one year as per Ord No. 398-2022 – original amount was \$86,056 and then they added \$90,000 in 2020 and \$90,000 in 2021 for a total of \$266, 056. The total funds expended were \$138,132.46 leaving a balance of \$127,923.54 as of April 14, 2023.

Remaining Balance: \$127,924

Contract No. PS 2019-150 with **College Now Greater Cleveland, Inc.**, extended for one year as per Ord. No. 398-2022 – has 3 lines for 3 years for a total of \$247,000. The total funds expended were \$148,600, leaving a balance of \$98,400 as of April 14, 2023.

Remaining Balance: \$98,400

Research has shown that providing these types of programs and activities to youth helps to reduce violence and supports the development of the knowledge/skills necessary for success in school, the workforce, home and the community.

The requested legislation will allow the Office of Prevention, Intervention and Opportunity for Youth and Young Adults to continue offering expanded programs and activities that meet the needs of our community.
