

Resolution No. 516-2023

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Declaring the intent to vacate all of the remaining portion of an unnamed alley, from the northerly line of Permanent Parcel No. 003-23-019 to the centerline of Gould Court.

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate the remaining portion of the unnamed alley, as described; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council declares its intent to vacate the following described real property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as being all of the remaining portion of an unnamed alley (16.5 feet wide) shown on the Willeyville Allotment of part of the Original Brooklyn Township Lot No. 70, as shown by the plat recorded in Volume 2, Page 16 of Cuyahoga County Map Records and being further bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northerly line of a parcel of land known as being Parcel 1-A in the Columbus Hill-Kamis Properties LLC Lot Split & Consolidation Plat, as shown by the recorded plat in Volume 373 of Maps, Page 85 of Cuyahoga County Records also known as Permanent Parcel Number (PPN) 003-23-019, extending northerly, to the centerline of Gould Court (16.5'),

Legal Description approved by Eric B. Westfall, P.S., Section Chief,
Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section.

Section 2. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
