Process

- July 2022: Formed internal City Hall working group
- September 2022: Passed Res. No. 954-2022, formally established working group to study Community Benefit Agreement policies and ordinances
- October November 2022: Conducted construction industry stakeholder focus groups
- December 2022 Present: Online community survey
 - 350+ responses as of May 6, 2023
- March 2023: Introduced Community Benefit Ordinance (Ord. No. 297-2023)



Community Survey Results*

What concerns do you have about new construction?

- 1. Disruptions from construction (14%)

 Includes: increased traffic, debris, damage, noise, pollution, blocking walkways, etc.
- 2. Unaffordable housing or increasing housing costs (12%)
- 3. No concerns (9%)
- 4. No or not enough new construction (7%)
- 5. Lack of community benefit and involvement (7%)
- 6. Changing neighborhood aesthetic (6%)

What can be done to lessen your concerns?

- 1. Communicate with residents (15%)
- 2. No concerns (10%)
- 3. Community meetings/input (10%)
- 4. Minimize construction disruptions (9%)
 Includes: communicating traffic detours with residents, cleaning up construction debris, keeping walkways clear, set hours for noisy construction, etc.
- 5. Build affordable housing (6%)
- 6. Seeing improvements/building trust (5%)

- Youth programming
- Green/public space
- Affordable housing
- Neighborhood beautification/clean-up
- Employment, training opportunities for residents throughout all phases of development

- Home repair assistance to homeowners
- Demolish vacant structures
