PROGRAM SNR

**PURPOSE:** > The "Schools as a Neighborhood Resource" (SNR) program is a community-

based program in city areas considered service deficient.

> NLI conducts workshops in conjunction with the division's Youth Development Project and oversees the Summer Tennis Program.

Programming is designed to improve self-image, foster a sense of belonging, nurture relationships and instill a sense of community while providing an opportunity for fun through:

<u>Athletics</u> – Basic instruction in basketball, volleyball, track, open gym, weightlifting, floor hockey, soccer, karate and swimming.

<u>Aerobics</u> – Low and high impact style, free form dance and power walking.

Fine Arts – Arts and Crafts.

<u>Family Life/Community Forum</u> – This program is designed to improve the quality of life of the neighborhood residents and to offer community groups the opportunity to utilize the facility for meetings and public service events.

#### Summer Tennis Program

- Provides tennis instruction to at least 120 City youth, ages 8-18
- > Programs primary users are ages 8-18
- > Teaches backhand, lob and forehand shot, how to serve, rules of a single and double games, and scoring
- Tennis Sessions are provided in am and pm sessions. AM sessions are held from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon and PM Sessions are held from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
