

Ordinance No. 711-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts with AEM Commercial, Inc., to provide an Earth Networks sferic siren system and related equipment, services and software at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control, for a period of one year, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with AEM Commercial, Inc. to provide an Earth Networks sferic siren system and related equipment, services, and software at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, on the basis of its proposal dated May 8, 2023, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control, for a period of one year, with three one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control. The agreement shall include the City's obligation to pay a one-time subscription fee, installation service fee, and equipment purchase, and also pay ongoing subscriptions and service and maintenance fees for the term of the Agreement and any options exercised under this ordinance.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Port Control may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001 and 60 SF 141. (RQS 3001, RL 2023-68)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
