

Department of Port Control Request for Legislation

Ordinance No.: 584-2023

Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to supplement the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, by enacting a new Section relating to Peer-to-Peer Vehicle Sharing operating at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; Fee.

Peer-to-Peer Vehicle Sharing

(a) For purposes of this section, the following definitions apply:

(1) Peer-to-Peer Vehicle Sharing- The authorized use of a shared vehicle by an individual other than the shared vehicle owner through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program;

(2) Peer-to-Peer Vehicle Sharing Services- A business platform that connects shared vehicle owners with drivers to enable the sharing of vehicles for financial consideration;

(3) Shared Vehicle-A vehicle that is available for sharing through a peer-to-peer vehicle sharing program;

(b) No person or entity shall provide any peer-to-peer vehicle sharing services, unless it has been approved by Airport Management and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed under the rules and regulations promulgated by the Director.

(c) The Director is authorized to charge and collect a fee based upon the gross revenue of peer-to-peer vehicle sharing services on the property of the airport. The fee shall be in an amount set by the Board of Control.

(d) The Director may require an identifying decal to be displayed on all shared vehicles that operate on Airport property.

(e) The Director may require the purchase and use of equipment, or establish other appropriate mechanisms for monitoring and auditing compliance, including peer-to-peer vehicle sharing services provide data for purposes of monitoring and auditing compliance.

(f) The Director may designate a location where shared vehicles may stage in the Airport facility

(g) The Director is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations applicable to commercial ground transportation services. Such rules and regulations shall become effective ten (10) days after their publication in the City Record.
