**Pavement Management Survey, Analysis & Reporting**

**DIVISION:** Streets Maintenance

**ORD NO:** 591-2023

**LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:** An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more agreements with firms of consultants to provide professional services necessary to survey of all public roads within Cleveland’s Public Right of Way (the “Project”).

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Passage of this legislation will allow the Department of Public Works to hire a professional consultant to conduct a survey.

The City’s existing pavement management database contains a collection of Pavement Condition Rating (PCR) scores for a subset of streets and is tracked in our CityWorks Asset Management software (<https://www.cityworks.com/>). Streets are color coded and prioritized based on the PCR scores. The prioritized streets are then approximately equalized and distributed among wards.

The City’s annual road rehabilitation program has utilized the existing pavement management system and has defined the construction projects through, and including the 2023 construction season.

The results of this data collection will help determine the benefits and effectiveness of maintenance, resurfacing and reconstruction for all streets. The data will also be used to help prioritize improvements to local and major roads. It is the intent of the City to use the data derived from the survey to develop a five (5) year, rolling Capital Improvement Program (CIP) and a five (5) Road Maintenance Program.
