

# TRAFFIC CALMING

Physical design and other measures installed to reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety

### **Speed Tables**



Formed asphalt speed tables with associated signage, curbside delineators, and roadway striping

#### Modular Bus Platforms



Modular rubber bus platforms for safer transit operations and potential for protected bike lanes

### Traffic Circles








Traffic circles and/or miniroundabouts at key residential intersections

### Signal Upgrades





Signal detection, ADA push buttons and signage, pedestrian countdown signal heads, retroreflective backplates for Vision Zero corridors.

#### School Zone Flashers




Automates 20 mph school zone flashers; solar panels at 10 locations


