To authorize the Director of Capital Projects or the Director of Public Works to enter into contracts to make the improvements; to employ architects, landscape architects, and engineers, to provide professional services; and direct employment

of the necessary labor.

This is the annual operating legislation to allow the use of capital bond sales to perform capital improvements to City recreation

facilities.
