

Purpose:	This Department requests legislation to grant consent to ODOT to construct Ramp Safety Improvements at West Blvd. at the Interstate 90 ramp, PID 119472, in the City of Cleveland and to authorize the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one or more agreements with ODOT to make the improvement.	
Description:	ODOT will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 100% of the eligible costs. The ramp safety improvement project within the City of Cleveland includes enhancements to pavement markings, signage, new roadway features and updated signalization. The roadway features consist of ADA curb ramps, curb extensions, a median islands and improved curb radii. The signalization consists of upgraded vehicular and pedestrian signals. These enhancements are part of ODOT's ongoing efforts to improve pedestrian safety on or adjacent to Highways within the State.
