### Establishment of a Transportation Demand Management Program

Ordinance No:	<b>801-2023</b>
Purpose:	Authorizing the Director of City Planning to establish a Transportation Demand Management program as an alternative to requirements for the minimum number of accessory off-street vehicular parking spaces.
Description:	<p>AN ORDINANCE To supplement the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, by enacting new Sections 301.01 to 301.09 relating to transit oriented development and transportation demand management; and to amend Section 341.02, as amended by Ordinance No. 1872-08, passed February 9, 2009, and Section 349.11, as amended by Ordinance No. 1236-A-67, passed June 28, 1971, relating to applicability and exceptions to minimum parking requirement.</p> <p>This ordinance authorizes the Director of City Planning to establish a Transportation Demand Management Program in lieu of requirements for a minimum number of accessory off-street parking spaces for the purpose of supporting transit-oriented development and the welfare of the region's bus and rail transit system, promoting sustainable and efficient land use, and encouraging multiple modes of transportation.</p>
