AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance 1262-2023, passed October 30, 2023, relating to the agreement with Burten Bell Carr Development Corporation for the 2023 Food Card Distribution Program.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1262-2023, passed October 30, 2023, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$70,750.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188 using the fund and project number from the following Wards:

Ward 6	\$33,250.00	G23632
Ward 5	\$37,500.00	G23632

<u>Section 2.</u> That the existing Section 2 of Ordinance 1262-2023, passed October 30, 2023, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
