AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts with AeroCloud System Inc., for the purpose of providing an automated airport gate scheduling and billing management software solution for the Common Use Airport Operations program, for the Department of Port Control, for a period of oneyear, with five one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with AeroCloud System Inc., for the purpose of providing an automated airport gate scheduling and billing management software solution for the Common Use Airport Operations program, on the basis of its proposal with an effective date of April 1, 2024, for the Department of Port Control, for a period of one-year, with five one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Port Control.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Port Control may sign all documents that are necessary to obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. The contract or contracts shall be paid from Fund No. 60 SF 001. (RQS 3001, RL 2024-49)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
