

Ordinance No. 937-2024

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS2023-0298 with PMG Executive Program Management, LLC to provide executive airport development programming, financing, planning, design and related services.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 470-2023, passed May 8, 2023, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2023-0298 with PMG Executive Program Management, LLC to provide executive airport development programming, financing, planning, design and related services; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 470-2023 requires additional legislation to exercise the first, second, third and fourth options to renew; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. PS2023-0298 with PMG Executive Program Management, LLC to provide executive airport development programming, financing, planning, design and related services. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 470-2023 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
