

Ordinance No. 1310-2024

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Excellence, Inc. to provide repair and maintenance services to an ambulance vehicle currently under warranty with Excellence Inc., for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Excellence, Inc. Therefore, the Director of Public Works is authorized to make one or more written contracts with Excellence, Inc. on the basis of its proposals both dated February 15, 2024, in the total sum of \$90,562.88, to provide repair and maintenance services to an ambulance vehicle, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Emergency Medical Service, Department of Public Safety. The contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 70 SF 300. (RQS 7015, RL 2024-125)

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
