**SUBJECT:** Ordinance No. 1351-2024 authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the FY2025 Impaired Driving Enforcement Program and Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (IDEP/STEP)

### **Purpose:**

Ordinance Number 1351-2024, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety for the FY25 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) and Impaired Driving Enforcement Program (IDEP) Grant.

### **Purpose of Grant:**

The goal of the Impaired Driving Enforcement Program (IDEP) and Strategic Traffic Enforcement (STEP) Grant is to provide funding for OVI-related and speed-related traffic enforcement. The City will receive reimbursement for Police Officer overtime while conducting targeted enforcement.

### **For the last grant year, the following was accomplished:**

16 Adult Restraint Citations  
1 Child Restraint Citation  
7 Speed Citations  
1 Distracted Driving Citation  
3 Driving Under Suspension Arrests  
46 Other Citations

### **Expenses to be reimbursed:**

Personnel:	\$ 61,769.16 (Police Officer Overtime)
Education:	\$ 3,500.00 (Posters, flyers on traffic safety)
Fuel:	\$ <u>2,553.50</u>
Total:	\$ 67,822.66

- The grant period is 10/01/24 – 9/30/25
- We have received this grant annually since 2008
- There is no local match
