

Ordinance No. 893-18

**Council Members Brancatelli and Kelley
(by departmental request)**

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Appropriating Community Development Block Grant funds for anti-predatory lending and foreclosure prevention assistance, financial literacy programs, fair housing, and administrative costs to implement the programs.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland has received a Community Development Block Grant, PY2018, from the United States Government; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That CDBG funds in the amount of \$85,950 are appropriated for anti-predatory lending and foreclosure prevention assistance, financial literacy programs, fair housing, and administrative costs to implement the programs.

Section 2. That the Director of Community Development is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with various organizations to provide counseling, training, marketing, program evaluation and other services required for anti-predatory lending and foreclosure prevention assistance, financial literacy, fair housing activities and to expend funds for administrative costs to implement the programs.

Section 3. That the aggregate cost of the contracts and administrative costs shall not exceed \$85,950, plus any prior balances and program income, and shall be paid from Fund No. 14 SF 044. (RQS 8006, RL 2018-0070)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
