## Ordinance No. 897-18

# Council Members McCormack, Brancatelli and Kelley (by departmental request)

#### **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into an amendment to the Lease By Way of Concession with the Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation entered into on June 22, 2015, to provide an initial 20-year term with a 20-year option to renew of the Lease and to sublease portions of the property to various non-profit health and human service organizations.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 565-15, passed June 1, 2015, this Council authorized a Lease By Way of Concession between The Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation entered into on June 22, 2015 ("the Lease") to operate the May Dugan Multi-Service Center to provide social services to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Lease was for an initial 10-year period with a ten-year option to renew; and

WHEREAS, The Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation wishes to have an initial 20-year term with a 20-year option to renew the Lease and to sublease space to various non-profit health and human service organizations to provide additional services to the community; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Community Development is authorized to enter into an amendment to the Lease with The Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation, or its designee, to provide an initial 20-year term with a 20-year option to renew the Lease and to sublease space in the leased premises to various non-profit health and human service organizations to provide additional services to the community. All other terms of the Lease shall remain the same.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the Director of Law shall prepare the amendment.

Section 3 That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
