

Ordinance No. 1030-18

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of City Planning to accept gift of preliminary plans and other deliverables from YMCA for the update of the City's Master Bikeway plan.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of City Planning is authorized to accept gift of preliminary plans and other deliverables from YMCA for the update of the City's Master Bikeway plan, with an estimated value of \$42,355.00.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
