<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or

more contracts with the Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority to provide technical

assistance and to procure a comprehensive maritime infrastructure assessment of the

City-owned properties commonly known as Docks 28b, 30, 32 and the North Coast

Harbor.

Section 2. That the cost of the contract shall not exceed \$115,000 and shall

be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 113, RQS 3002, RL 2018-89.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
