AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Declaring the intent to vacate a portion of
Maplewood Avenue.

Brancatelli (by departmental request)

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate a portion of
Maplewood Avenue, as described; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the
usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the
following described real property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as
being part of Original Rockport Township sections No. 3 and 4 being further described
as follows:

Maplewood Avenue (60.00 feet wide)

Being all that portion of Maplewood Avenue (60.00 feet wide) extending from the West
right of way of Rocky River Drive (Width Varies) westerly to that portion of Maplewood
Avenue vacated by City of Cleveland Ordinance No. 1598-98 passed November 23,
1998.

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House
Numbering Section.

Section 2. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and,
provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval
by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest
period allowed by law.
