AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Withdrawing objection to the renewal of a D2, D2X, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit at 4170 Lee Road and repealing Resolution No. 815-16 objecting to said renewal.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to the renewal of a D2, D2X, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit, Permit No. 2830807 owned by 4170 Lee Road Tavern, LLC, DBA New Sir Rah House, 4170 Lee Road and patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44128, by Resolution No. 815-16 adopted by the Council on July 13, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the renewal of a D2, D2X, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit, Permit No. 2830807 owned by 4170 Lee Road Tavern, LLC, DBA New Sir Rah House, 4170 Lee Road and patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44128, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 815-16, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
