AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 906-18, passed August 15, 2018, relating to registration of police alarm system users.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the

usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 906-18, passed August 15, 2018,

is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That existing Sections 670.01 <u>670A.01</u> and 670A.03 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1585-90, passed January 7, 1991, and Ordinance No. 220-11, passed March 28, 2011, are repealed.

Section 2. That existing Section 2 of Ordinance No. 906-18, passed August

15, 2018, is repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
