Purpose: Legislation to amend Ordinance No. 628-17, passed by

City Council on June 5, 2017 to increase Cleveland contribution from approximately twenty-one (21%) estimated at \$1,050,000 to approximately twenty-nine

(29%) estimated at \$1,685,329.

Description: City granted consent to Garfield Heights to apply for and

accept Ohio Public Works Commission Issue 1 funds which will partially finance the roadway improvement within the Cites of Garfield Heights and Cleveland. The project was on the Issue 1 contingency funding list last year and did not receive funding. The Cites will contribute additional funds this year to compete for an Issue grant award. Johnston Parkway is an industrial/ business access road that serves 15 Cleveland businesses with total of 500 employees. The work includes removing the existing

concrete road and installing a new concrete pavement with drainage, ada ramps, curb and driveways, and sidewalk if necessary. The road is 6,700 feet in length with 2,600 feet

in Garfield Heights and 4,440 feet in Cleveland.
