Nursing home services provide more intensive medical and nursing care to adults following a hospitalization or decline in physical or cognitive health. Adults can receive around the clock care in a nursing home on a long-term or short-term basis, typically provided through rehabilitation therapy. Rehabilitation is provided through physical, occupational, and speech therapy's and is intended to prepare the adult to return to the community. Nursing homes are categorized as skilled nursing facilities that participate in both Medicare and Medicaid or as nursing facilities which participate in Medicaid only.¹
