Council Members Cleveland and Kelley (by departmental request)

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with American Airlines, Inc., for the purchase of up to to purchase and refurbish five used passenger boarding bridges and to refurbish up to five other passenger boarding bridges, including but not limited to associated labor, equipment, materials, or services, for the Division of Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than American Airlines, Inc. ("American"). Therefore the Director of Port Control is authorized to make one or more written contracts with American for the purchase of up to to purchase and refurbish five used passenger boarding bridges and to refurbish up to five other passenger boarding bridges, including but not limited to associated labor, equipment, materials, or services, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Cleveland Hopkins International Airport, Department of Port Control.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Port Control may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. The contract or contracts authorized shall not exceed \$2,100,000 and shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001, 60 SF 104, 60 SF 105, 60 SF 115, 60 SF 116, 60 SF 126, 60 SF 128, 60 SF 130, 60 SF 141, 60 SF 160, and the fund or funds to which are credited any grants received for this purpose. (RQS 3001, RL 2018-32)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
