# Ordinance No. 1334-18

## **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Council Member Kelley (by departmental request)

To amend Section 48 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 48 of Ordinance No. 323-15, passed March 30, 2015, as amended by Ordinance No. 858-15, passed August 19, 2015, Ordinance No. 650-16, passed June 6, 2016, Ordinance No. 1343-16, passed November 21, 2016, Ordinance No. 950-17, passed September 18, 2017, Ordinance No. 320-18, passed March 26, 2018, and Ordinance No. 730-18, passed June 4, 2018, is amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
