## **Grant of Easements to Metroparks for Whiskey Island Connector**

| Project Summary:     | The Whiskey Island Connector is a proposed 1 mile<br>all-purpose trail adjacent to Whiskey Island Drive<br>that connects Edgewater Park and Wendy<br>Park/Whiskey Island.  |
|                      | In July 2016, Cleveland Metroparks, in partnership<br>with The Trust for Public Land and LAND studio, was<br>awarded \$7.950 million for the Re-Connecting<br>Cleveland: Pathways to Opportunity grant<br>application in the highly competitive Transportation<br>Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER)<br>grant program through the US Department of<br>Transportation to construct the Whiskey Island<br>Connector, Wendy Park Bridge, and two other trail<br>projects in the city of Cleveland. |
|                      | The Whiskey Island Connector also received funding<br>through the State of Ohio's Capital Fund, Clean Ohio<br>Trails Fund, and various foundations from within and<br>around Northeastern Ohio.  |
|                      | The Whiskey Island Connector will provide access<br>between the two park areas, and will connect to a<br>new Wendy Park Bridge and the larger trail network,<br>including the Towpath Trail.   |
