LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: To supplement the Codified Ordinances to create the Ethiopian Garden within the Cleveland Cultural Gardens.

The Ethiopian Garden requested and the Cleveland Cultural Garden Federation approved the request to designate the Ethiopian Garden in the Cleveland Cultural Gardens. This will be the first of an African nation. The stele will be an archway site, 30 feet tall and made of stone. There will be a 5-panel mosaic art wall (12.18) with concrete pillars, describing the history of Ethiopia. There is a doorway in solid stone from a single 30-ton piece of stone for a future phase.
