
Proposal

To change the Use, Area and Height Districts in the Lincoln Heights and Queen Barber neighborhoods.

Purpose

To replace the heavy industry zoning between Fulton Road and 90/71 with commercial and residential zoning categories. The proposal will align with the principals laid out in the Connecting Cleveland 2020 Plan (citywide plan). Further, adding the Urban Form (UF) Overlay represents an opportunity to ensure that subsequent redevelopment follows sound urban design principles to encourage walkability and neighborhood-friendly building design.
