Description:

Legislation authorizing the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects or the Director of Public Works to apply, accept, expend and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for a Land and Water Conservation Fund grant in support of redevelopment of Estabrook Recreation Center playground area.

Purpose:

Creating a universal design playground at Estabrook Recreation Center Park. This design goes beyond ADA compliance and makes concentrated efforts to have many design elements that will encourage inclusive play, allowing children of all abilities and adults of all ages to access the structure at its highest levels without barriers. Due to the distinctive landscape, tremendous efforts went into creating a unique play structure that will be one of a kind in universal design for Cleveland. The addition of a new pavilion, seating and picnic tables will further enhance the user experience, all of which will be ADA compliant.

The Land and Water Conservation Fund grant is a matching reimbursement grant. The total estimated costs associated with the redevelopment for the project are \$528, 357. The city would be reimbursed at a 1:1 ratio, equaling \$264,178.50. The council president has been made aware of this opportunity and consents to this project.
