Third Year: 2.0 % wage increase

**Section 14. Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association Utilities Police Officers).**

Salaries and compensation for all persons employed in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification.
