AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 801-18, passed July 18, 2018, relating to a contract with SIFCO Industries, Inc., or its designee, for economic development assistance to partially finance the acquisition of machinery and equipment for its business at 970 East 64th Street.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 801-18, passed July 18, 2018, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5. That the Director of Economic Development is authorized to accept monies in repayment of the loan and to deposit the monies in Fund No. $\frac{17 \text{ SF } 006}{12 \text{ SF } 958}$.

Section 2. That existing Section 5 of Ordinance No. 801-18, passed July 18, 2018, is repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
