AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1411-18 passed November 19, 2018, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Famicos Foundation for the Holiday Food Gift Card Program through the use of Wards 4, 7, 8, 9 and 10 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1411-18 passed November 19, 2018, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$126,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1411-18 passed November 19, 2018, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
