AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 961-17, passed August 16, 2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 637-18, passed May 14, 2018, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Health to enter into an agreement with Ohio University for the Aspiring Doctors Pre-College Program through the use of Ward 13 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 961-17, passed August 16, 2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 637-18, passed May 14, 2018, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of <u>Public Health</u> is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective <u>January 1, 2019</u>, with Ohio University for the Aspiring Doctors Pre-College Program for the public purpose of providing educational programming and mentoring for city of Cleveland youth who are interested in a medical career through the use of Ward <u>13</u> Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 961-17, passed August 16, 2017, as amended by Ordinance No. 637-18, passed May 14, 2018, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
