AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 814-18, passed July 18, 2018, relating to the purchase, lease, or lease with option to purchase, of various on-road vehicles and off-road equipment, cabs, bodies, and accessories, equipment and other aftermarket items necessary to equip the vehicles; and to supplement the ordinance by adding new Section 3a, to add an additional funding source for eligible vehicles.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual

daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the title and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 814-18, passed July 18,

2018, is amended to read as follows:

An emergency ordinance authorizing the purchase by one or more standard and requirement contracts for the purchase, lease, or lease with option to purchase, of various on-road vehicles and off-road equipment, cabs, bodies, and accessories, equipment and other aftermarket items necessary to equip the vehicles authorized for their intended purposes, including vehicle rehabilitation, training, and inspections, as needed, for the various divisions of City government, for a period of one year; and authorizing the director to apply for and accept funding from the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District under the Community Cost Share Program for eligible vehicles.

Section 2. That the costs of the contract or contracts shall be <u>paid from the fund</u> <u>or funds to which are credited the NEORSD Community Cost Share Program funds</u> <u>authorized by this ordinance and/or shall also be</u> charged against the proper appropriation accounts and the Director of Finance shall certify the amount of any purchase <u>or procurement</u> under the contract, each of which purchases <u>or procurements</u> shall be made on order of the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies by a delivery order issued against the contract or contracts and certified by the Director of Finance. Section 2. That existing Section 2 of Ordinance No. 814-18, passed July 18, 2018, is

repealed.

Section 3. That Ordinance No. 814-18, passed July 18, 2018, is supplemented by

adding new Section 3a to read as follows:

Section 3a. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to apply for and accept funding from the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District under the NEORSD Community Cost Share Program to pay the cost of the Division of Water Pollution Control vehicles that are eligible under the program for reimbursement; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the program; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in this ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
