AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Clerk of Council to enter into an agreement with NetX Internet LLC to provide wireless internet service to Cleveland City Council.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter into an agreement with NetX Internet LLC to provide wireless internet service to Cleveland City Council, including installation, equipment, management, maintenance and repair, and 100MB of data per month, for a period of three years, beginning on January 1, 2019. The cost of the agreement shall be \$999 per month and shall be paid from fund 01, dept. 0101 subfund 001 object code 6320.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
