## **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to exercise the option to renew Contract No. CT 7004 PS 2018-102 with The Davey Tree Expert Company to perform external landscape and maintenance of the Highland Park Golf Course.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 568-18, passed May 14, 2018, the Director of Public Works entered into Contract No. CT 7004 PS 2018-102 with the Davey Tree Expert Company to to perform external landscape and maintenance of the Highland Park Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 568-18 requires further legislation before exercising the option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to exercise the option to renew Contract No. CT 7004 PS 2018-102 with The Davey Tree Expert Company for professional services to perform external landscape and maintenance of the Highland Park Golf Course. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 568-18 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
