LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:

This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Works to employ one or more professional consultants to provide security services at various indoor/outdoor recreation facilities, recreation centers, outdoor pools and surrounding

play areas as required.

**CONTRACT TERMS:** 

One year period

• September 1, 2019 – August 31, 2020

CONTRACT AMOUNT:

\$896,739

**Recreation Centers:** Off-duty officers will be assigned to all 21 recreation centers for four hours per day: Monday thru Friday 4 p.m. until 8 p.m. and Saturdays 2 p.m. until 6 p.m. Officers will be deployed at the following sites all year round:

During the summer months from June 8, 2019 thru August 4, 2019 and officers will be placed at outdoor pools from 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Wednesday through Sunday. If the temperature is above 85 degrees Monday – Tuesdays then we will require security on those days as well.
