Being all that portion of the Clark Avenue Extension S.W. (63.00 feet wide) as shown on the Clark Street Extension Dedication Plat in Volume 12 of Maps, Page 2 & 3 of Cuyahoga County Records, extending from the West right of way of West 5th Street (60.00 feet wide, now vacated) as shown on the Vacation Plat of part of North Clark Ave. S.W. 50', W. 3rd St.-50' & W. 5th St.-60' in Volume 227 of Maps, Page 13 of Cuyahoga County Records, easterly to the Cuyahoga River.

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
